The Sports Development Program is a joint initiative between Netball Victoria, SEDA (Sports Education and Development Australia) and Victoria University, specifically designed for young people who would like to pursue a Sport and Recreation related career.

If you are a current year 10, 11 or 12 student you can complete your VCE, VCAL and Certificates III and IV in Sport and Recreation leading to a Diploma of Sport (Development).

Core curriculum involves theoretical and practical experience in sports administration, marketing, fitness, coaching, event/project management, literacy, numeracy and career planning.

WHAT'S IN IT FOR ME?

The Netball Victoria Sports Development Program provides:

- an excellent pathway into higher education at Victoria University
- the opportunity to work closely with expert staff at Netball Victoria
- a Netball Victoria Sports Development Program uniform
